It is a unique initiative among the events previously organized by the IUSVE Department of Psychology.

On the one hand, the main objective is to explore and discuss emerging trends and current challenges in psychology; on the other hand, the event seeks to serve as a platform for the exchange of innovative ideas and scientific debate among international experts and participants from various academic and professional backgrounds, with the active involvement of students. For the first time, the congress will see university students not only as attendees but also as co-authors of some of the works presented. This marks an important step toward integrating students into high-level clinical and research activities, demonstrating our commitment to providing them with meaningful international training opportunities.

- > Encourage Student Participation: Motivate psychology students and early-career researchers to present their work, providing them with an international stage and the opportunity to receive constructive feedback from field experts.
- > Integrate Theory and Practice: Showcase the effectiveness of psychological theories through empirical studies and practical case applications, emphasizing the importance of evidence-based approaches.
- Support Continuing Professional Development: Offer learning and professional development opportunities through workshops, seminars, and expert interactions, strengthening competencies necessary to tackle contemporary psychological challenges.
